



Casey Weinstein Ohio Senator

Senator Casey Weinstein is completing his first (1st) term in the Ohio Senate after having completed three (3) terms in the Ohio House of Representatives. He represents the Akron area and serves as Ranking Member on both the Senate Armed Services, Veteran Affairs, and Public Safety Committee and the Government Oversight and Reform Committee. He is a member of the Senate Addiction and Community Resources Committee, and the Higher Education, and Energy committees. In 2020, he was appointed by Governor Mike DeWine to serve on the state's Holocaust and Genocide Memorial Committee. Prior to running for election, he served as Hudson City Councilman.

In July he was recognized as Ohio's State Legislative Champion by Mental Health America for his work advancing policies that strengthen the behavioral health system, expand prevention and treatment resources, reduce barriers to care, and improve the lives of people living with mental health and substance abuse disorders.

He is a graduate of the US. Air Force Academy and served on active duty as Deputy Chief of the Information Services Assurances at the Space and Missile Systems Center in California and as a manager of maintenance support at Wright-Patterson Airforce Base. He received his MBA from The Ohio State University Fisher College of Business in 2007 and currently is a director for ServiceNow Inc. an information technology firm.

He married his Air Force Academy classmate who is an economics professor at Akron University. They have three children.
